- **Gaming Permit**

As a club who participates in a game of skill and chance, CIA holds a gaming permit. CIA has been contacted about having Tudor Bingo play CIA's permit for a period of time. With it comes the possibility of extra money for the club which could be used to help maintain our buildings, signs, targets, etc. Officers and other recent meeting attendees have discussed the risks, read the contract, and have talked with other non-profits who have played their permit. All non-profits that were contacted had a positive experience and have made some extra funds for their organization. A vote was taken and it was decided to play the permit if the opportunity officially arises.



- **Membership Cards**

Make sure to carry your membership card with you when shooting on the range. This is a request by the municipality to make sure that those on the property are members of a user club (CIA, Fun-Flyers, & Equestrian clubs). This is in our best interest. It is possible you could be checked by a police officer or municipal worker and removed from the property if you cannot provide proof of membership.

The last couple years we have had folks participate in a gear swap at the May 3-D shoot. If you have any archery or outdoor equipment you have been meaning to get rid of, please consider bringing it to the May shoot to see if someone would be interested in it.
